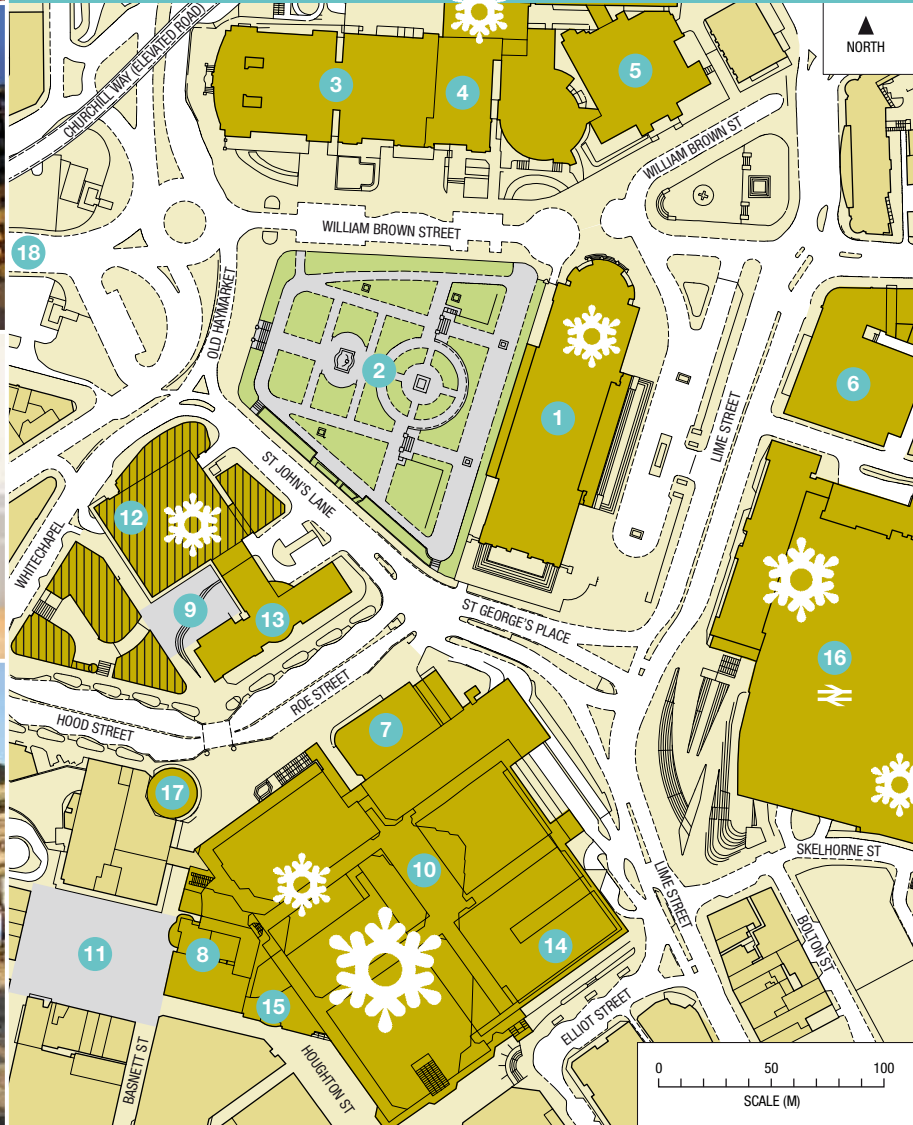

7 November - 16 January 2016

This winter the iconic Weeping Window sculpture will go on display at one of Europe's finest buildings - St George's Hall, as part of 14-18 NOW: WW1 Centenary Art Commissions.

A cascade of several thousand handmade ceramic poppies, the dramatic piece was one of the key elements in the installation *Blood Swept Lands and Seas of Red* at the Tower of London in the autumn of 2014.

The breath-taking installation marked the centenary of the outbreak of WWI, a time which in Liverpool saw thousands of men sign up at St George's Hall to create the Pal's Regiments.

Poppies: Weeping Window is designed to encourage reflection and remembrance.

It is an opportunity to learn about the lives of those who have been lost in conflict, the role Liverpool has played and to bring to life the stories of those who went to the front line but also those who have stayed behind and kept the home fires burning.

When visiting *Poppies: Weeping Window* there are a number of additional activities, events and educational resources which are available for children and adults. Why not share your memories, thoughts and feelings online with us?

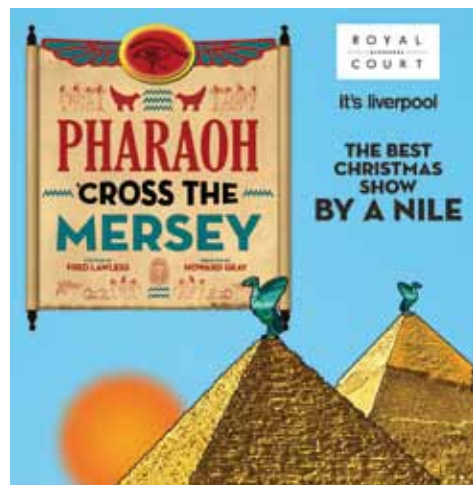
